The Okotoks Oilers Athletic Association (OOAA) is the draw zone association for the AAA programs servicing Okotoks Minor Hockey, Foothills Minor Hockey and the Wheatland Athletic Association. In addition, we are responsible for oversight of the AA teams for Okotoks Minor Hockey. Our program is proud to service both male (Oilers) and female (Rocky Mountain Raiders) programs that play in the AEHL and AFHL respectively.

Our team are broken into the following categories:

Male – U13AA, U15AA, U15AAA, U16AA, U17AAA, U18AA and U18AAA Female – U13AA, U15AA, U18AA and U18AAA AA Teams – 7 total AAA Teams – 4 total

A pillar of our program is the implementation of ice skills sessions and off ice academic support for each team. This service is provided via approved third-party vendors. This request for proposal (RFP) is an invitation to all interested parties to submit their proposal. The tender is broken down into 4 sections, with requirements for each section below. Tenderers are welcome to submit pricing for any relevant sections. A full submission is not required. All tenders will be reviewed by the OOAA Executive and Skills Development Committee prior to deciding. Candidates may be shortlisted and required to provide a short summary on their submission.

The terms of the contract are detailed below:

Term: Up to 2 years (Max) – subject to annual review Reporting structure: Coach Director Tender provides scheduling for applicable sessions with oversight from Coach Director Timing: Ideally sessions are front end loaded in season Tender for on ice sessions to be insured through Hockey Canada or Private insurance Tender to provide updated Vulnerable sector checks to OOAA

Proposed Sessions:

- 1. On Ice Skills Session length 112 total sessions
  - a. 1.25 hours/session
  - b. OOAA teams pay for ice
  - c. Tender provides one member to run sessions with at least one OOAA coach assisting
  - d. OOAA Coach Director & Head coach determine team requirements
  - e. Extra sessions may be requested by team and billed separate
